2019 Weakley Countian of the Year Cindy McAdams

The Weakley County Chamber of Commerce hosted the Annual Awards Banquet at UT Martin's Boling University Center Ballroom. Chamber members, Leadership graduates, and guest were present to recognize this year's honorees.

The 2019 Weakley Countian of the Year is Cindy McAdams. Mrs. McAdams was not your average busy mom raising two children, teaching, volunteering,

working a full time job, and working two part-time jobs. She taught and aided students who came to school lacking financial, emotional, and psychological support. Students hungry from not eating dinner the night before, tired from staying up caring for younger siblings or their own children, or tired from working late the night before to provide for their own families. She would teach students who wereon maternity, homebound, summer school, and before and after school tutoring to help ensure all students received their high school diploma to better themselves. Mrs. McAdams would take time off two nights a week from Walmart to teach her adult education classes. She had so much respect for these adults who wanted to better themselves no matter their age. Several of these adults did not have transportation. She would pick them up and drive them home after each class. She loved the drive and determination they had regarding education. Mrs. McAdams recently retired from education after 40 years, with 38 of those years dedicated to Greenfield School as a Special Education Teacher. She also taught Adult Basic Education classes at night for 17 years. Mrs. McAdams humble beginnings, years of over achieving drive, motivation, and passion have prepared her for her current position as the first and only lady as Greenfield Mayor.


